### Annual Health Screen Lab Consent Form for pets from two years through six years of age

As part of your pet's annual wellness evaluation program, we will give your pet a thorough physical examination. This procedure allows us to determine the overall physical health of your pet. Certain breeds of dogs and cats are pre-disposed to certain health problems and we will be looking for evidence of this type of health issue as well as any clinical signs associated with disease and/or injuries that may be present.

While our physical examination will help alert you to potential problems that may occur, it does not allow us to determine the general health of the internal organs. In order to properly evaluate the liver, kidneys, pancreas, etc., laboratory testing of samples from your companion during the annual health screening can be performed. This short laboratory procedure will detect liver and kidney problems, as well as check for diabetes.

We recommend this lab screening for all pets two years of age and older. As in all health evaluations, early detection is the key as it allows for more and better treatment options. The cost for this procedure is \$63.25. Patients seven years and older receive a more comprehensive lab exam designed to more thoroughly evaluate the aging pet companion.
